Resource and Reference Access Tips When Preparing for and Taking the MOSC Exam

Test-takers have multiple resources available to them for studying:

- "Bookshelf," a collection of online government reports and books, is accessible via <u>PubMed</u> (resource freely accessible).
- PubMed Central, known as PMC, contains 9.2 million full text articles (resource freely accessible).
- APTA members have additional access to scientific literature via <u>APTA Article Search</u> databases and <u>Rehabilitation Reference Center</u> (RRC). APTA Article Search includes access to more than 5,000 journals in full text, plus more than 9 million health care articles through our discovery service. RRC contains 800+ clinical summaries about health conditions that physical therapists see regularly in the clinic, plus a small collection of reference books; take the short 5-minute RRC <u>tutorial</u> to learn more.
